Peer Mentoring II is a continuation of Peer Mentoring I. Peer Mentoring is a one-year student leadership development opportunity. The on-campus commitment consists of consecutive fall and spring semesters. Mentors must complete an application and be accepted as a Peer Mentor to enroll in the course.
